

## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)**

### **Is the Inman Aligner new?**

Patients have been treated with Inman Aligners since 2000. In the United States approximately 450 to 500 new patients are prescribed treatment with Inman Aligners every month.

### **Is the Inman Aligner comparable to Invisalign?**

No.

The Inman Aligner is used for treating the top and bottom front teeth only. Invisalign can treat full arches (all your teeth).

### **Will treatment with the Inman Aligner be uncomfortable?**

No.

Due to the gentle but steady orthodontic forces generated, the appliances are easily tolerated. Your doctor may suggest aspirin or Tylenol for the 1st few days of treatment if you encounter any discomfort.

### **Will the Inman Aligner affect my speech?**

Yes.

The Inman Aligner will affect your speech for a week or two. You will however acclimate to the appliances over time and be able to speak fine with them in place.

### **Will I need to see the doctor frequently for adjustments?**

The Inman Aligners are pre-programmed to reduce the need for office visits. Your doctor will prescribe a treatment due to your needs.
